Updated Details: Food Pantry Information

Louisville Christian Assistance Center: Open to any Blount County resident. Please provide a photo ID. Clients may come as often as every 2 weeks. Clothing and personal hygiene items also available.

Chilhowee Baptist Center: Food supports by APPOINTMENT ONLY. Please provide a photo ID and proof of Blount County residency. There are Baptist Church affiliates conducting food distribution events throughout the county. Please also inquire about those events when calling. Clothing Pantry available.

Fairview Church: Provide proof of Blount County residency. They offer a clothing pantry on Thursdays by appointment only.

Community Food Connection: Recorded message verifies the days and times to receive prepacked food items. Also have miscellaneous items and pet food.

CROSS Food Ministries: Call (865) 579-6192 to see if your area is served. They also have clothing available and a thrift store.

Manna Outreach Ministries: Previous participants need their photo ID, while new participants need photo ID and a piece of mail from their residence. Clothing available.

Church of the Cove: Located very close to the Sevier Co. line, this location is not as close as other Blount County food pantries and may use more gas to get to their location, but they are very happy to serve anyone who comes on the 1st Saturday of the month from 9-11am. They are a Second Harvest distribution site, with some supplemental food items as the church can support. They do need a contact telephone #, if there is a food recall notification. This will be a drive through distribution.


Maryville Church of Christ: Food pantry is open without appointment on Tuesday. On other days, they can support by appointment only. Please leave a message if you get the church recording and the administrative staff will return the call and set

up a time for pick up.

Second Harvest: Due to community need, they have adjusted their processes to be able to possibly assist residents on an individual basis, yet please call 865-521-0000 to find out their process and hours. They have been extremely responsive to provide food for mass distribution efforts. Second Harvest is located at 136 Harvest Lane, Maryville, TN 37801.

RIO Townsend: Participants will need an ID and proof of residency such as mail.
