Dear Our Lady of Fatima Parishioners,

Greetings in the Lord. I want to inform you about an upcoming renovation project at our parish. We have been blessed with a beautiful environment in which to worship and practice the faith since the church's dedication in 2000. Over the last several years, we have had increasing need for meeting spaces. We now lack adequate space for adult and youth classes, the middle and high school education programs, music ministry, and other groups.

Several years ago, during planning for the Home Campaign, this renovation project was identified as a need for our growing parish with the campaign providing funding. However, the projected costs of this project exceed the remaining balance of the Home Campaign Fund. After careful consideration, this project has been approved by the Finance Committee and Parish Pastoral Council to receive additional funding from the Reserve Fund.

The project is twofold in that we will add an additional 1,000 square foot music room just past the nursery on the north side of our campus and remodel the current music room into two conference rooms that can be used for classrooms or meeting spaces.

The confirmed budget for the project is \$398,000. It will be funded by the Home Campaign balance of \$262,000 and \$136,000 from the Reserve Fund.

While this is a large amount, construction costs are not likely to decrease in the near future. Because of the funds that have been set aside, the Finance Committee, Parish Pastoral Council, and I have confidence that we can undertake this renovation without incurring debt. Additionally, our Blount County community is growing, and in the last 18 months, we have had 241 families join our parish. So we must prepare the best environment for our future church functions and ministries. I cannot thank you all enough for what you have done to support the finances our parish, especially during the last 2 years of COVID and to have fulfilled your Home Campaign pledges. Without these faith-filled efforts by you all, we could not consider such an improvement project.
