75th Anniversary Facts - Did You Know?

"From February 1995 through June 1996, OLOF experienced an especially busy and often stressful time. During this period, the sale of the old property was negotiated, and both an architect and contractor were selected for the parish's new home. While the AT&T building and house were being renovated, facilities for daily and weekend Masses had to be arranged. Weekend masses were celebrated at the Fine Arts Center at Maryville College, while daily mass took place in the basement of the present rectory."




St. Therese | Littlest Saints
