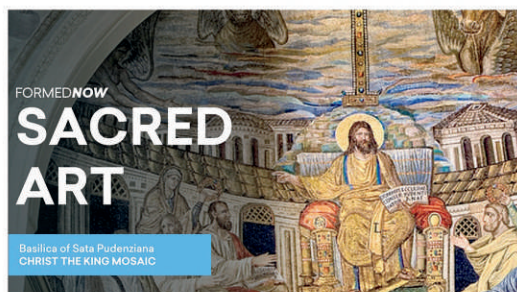
Retirement Fund For Religious
