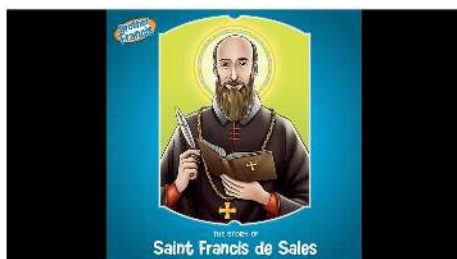
Saint Francis de Sales: Pastor of Souls
