### Ordination Mass of Deacon Daniel

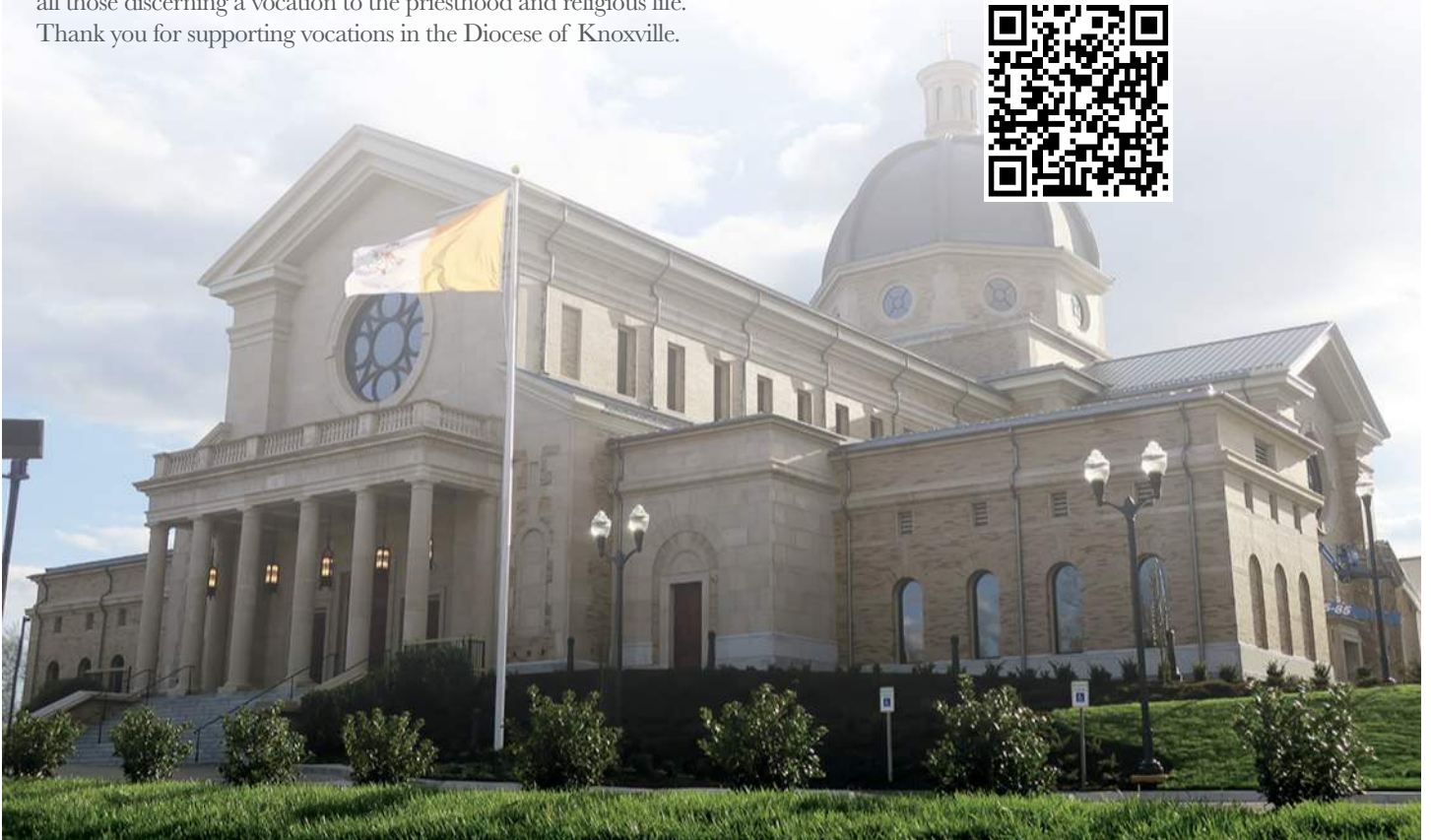

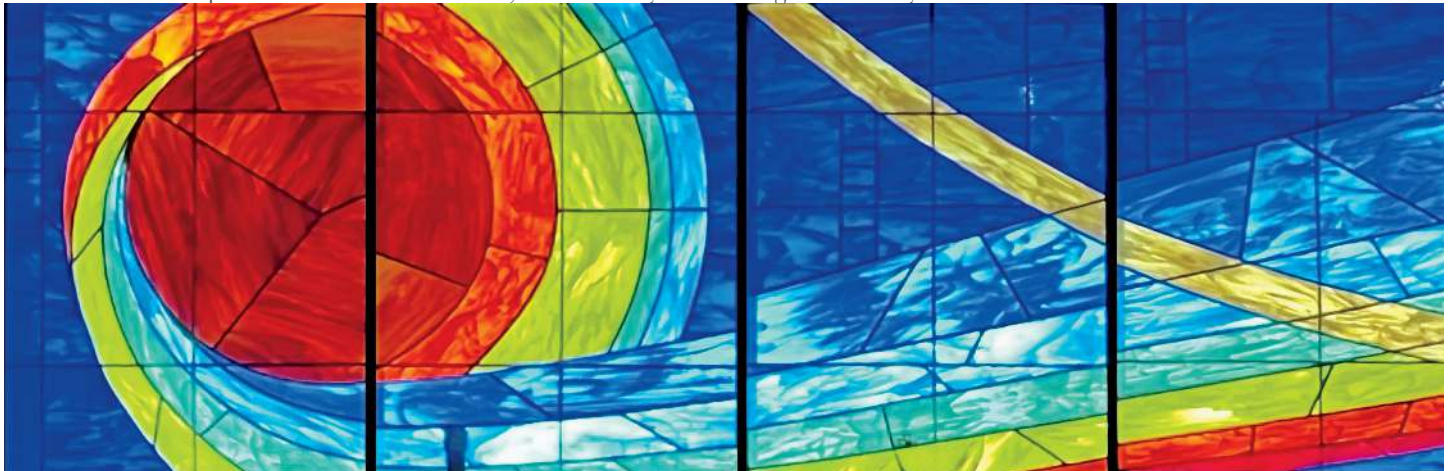
