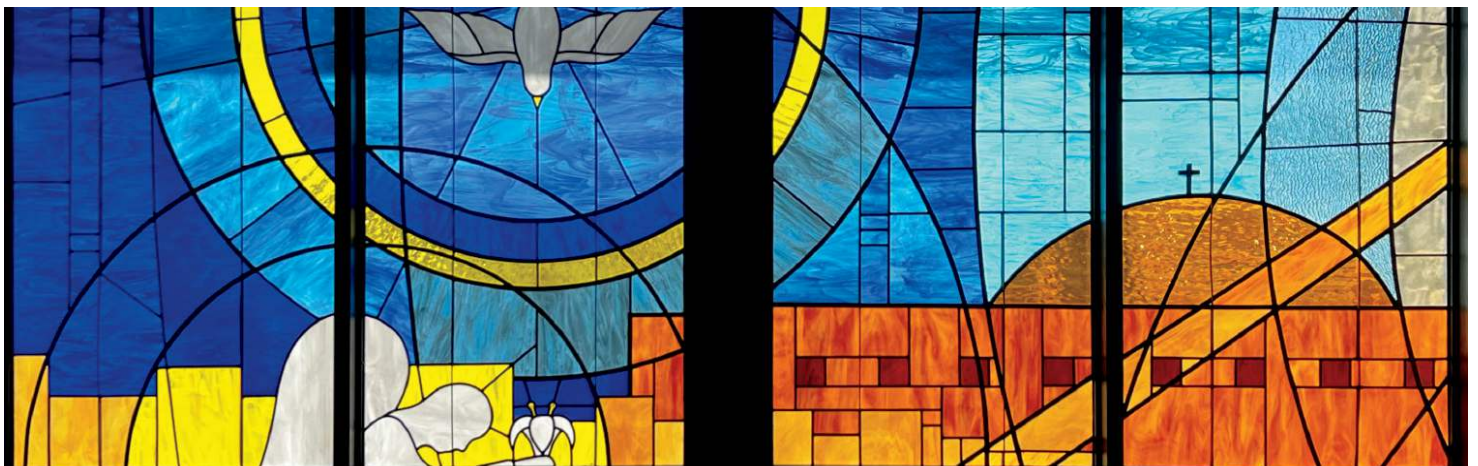
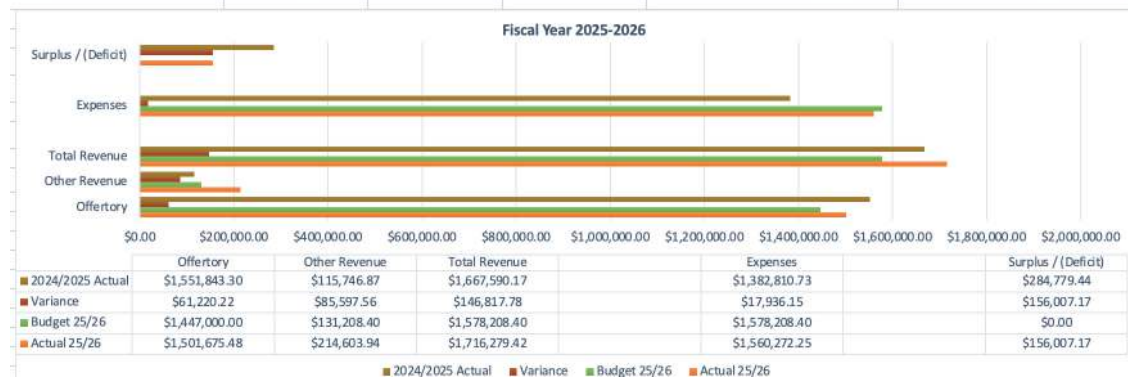


Fiscal Year 2025-2026

This report is as of the close of the Fiscal Year July 2025 through June 2026. You will see the Actual for the year to date, the Budget for year to date and the variance of Actual to Budget and Last year (2024-2025) actual, both in number and graph. I hope you find this helpful. Our expenses this past year were up \$128,772 over the 24/25 fiscal year, but that is understandable with adding a Family Life Coordinator and child care workers (salaries, taxes & benefits) as well as the 75th Anniversary expenses this past year. The sidewalks and stairs are completed, thank you to Sam the Concrete Man and the railings should be coming in the next couple of weeks. The finance committee is meeting this week to go over the budget for the new year, so I will have that to report soon. 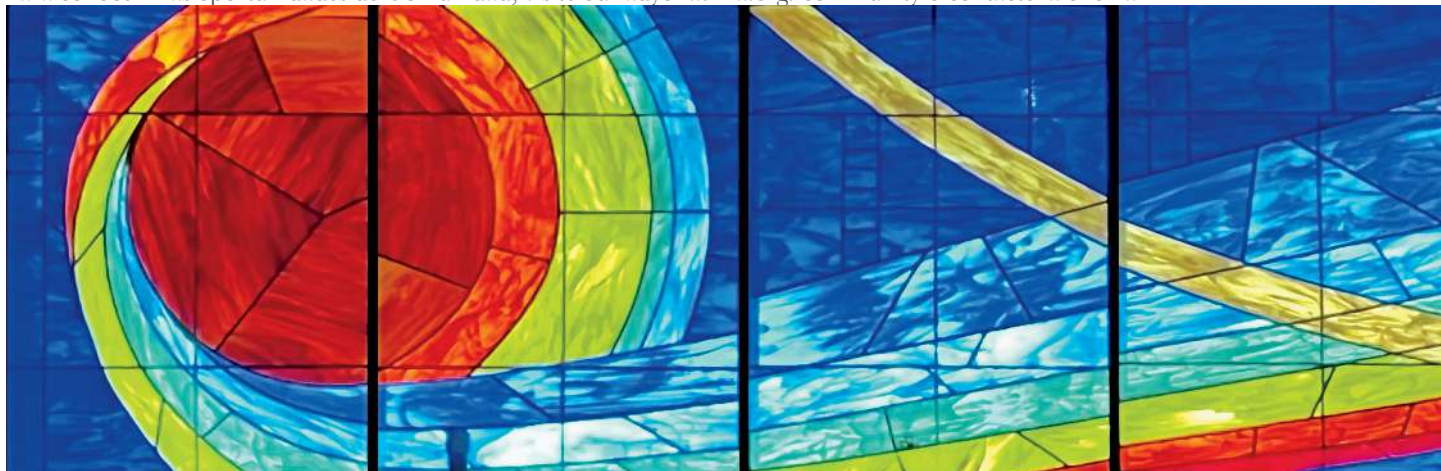
