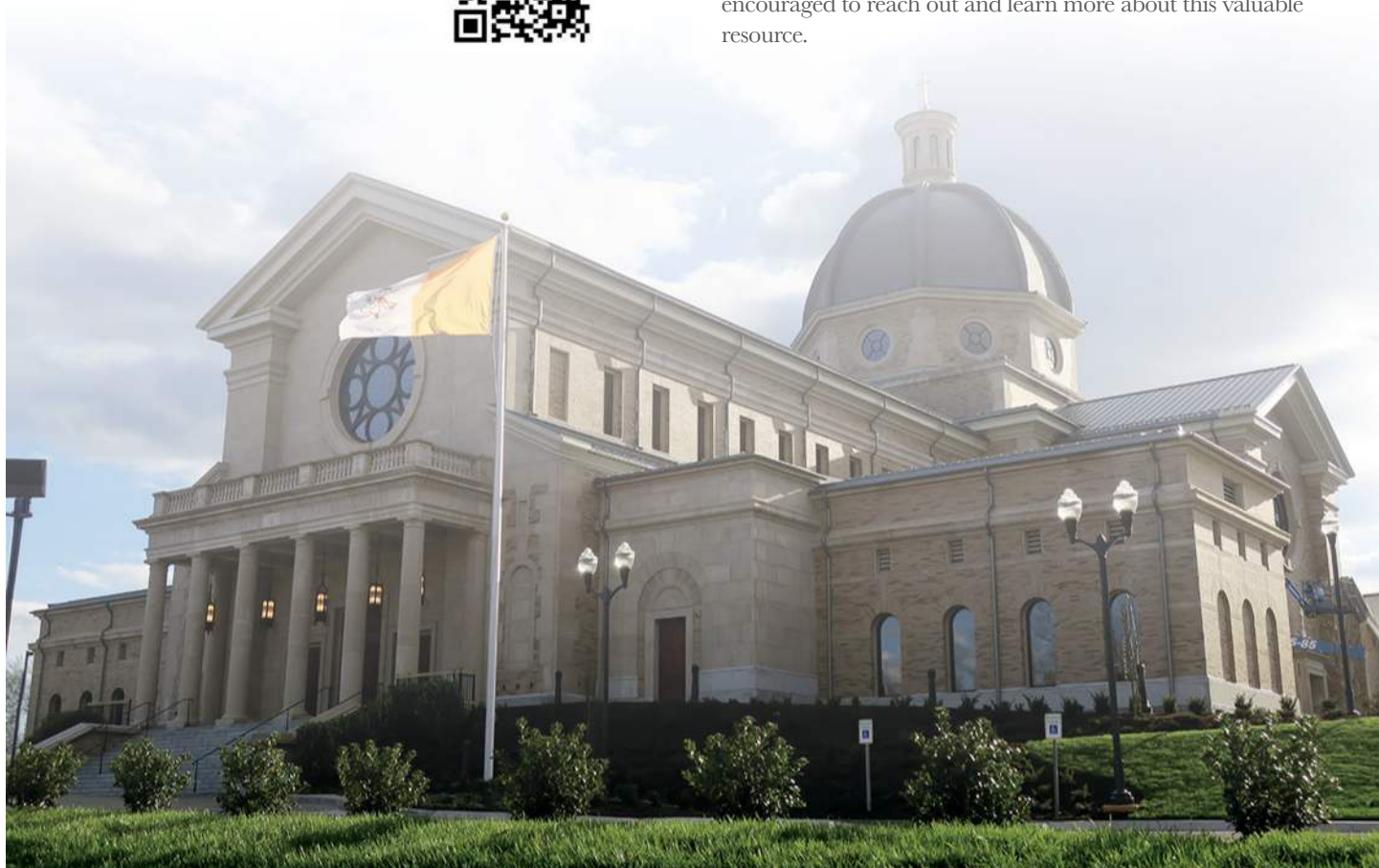

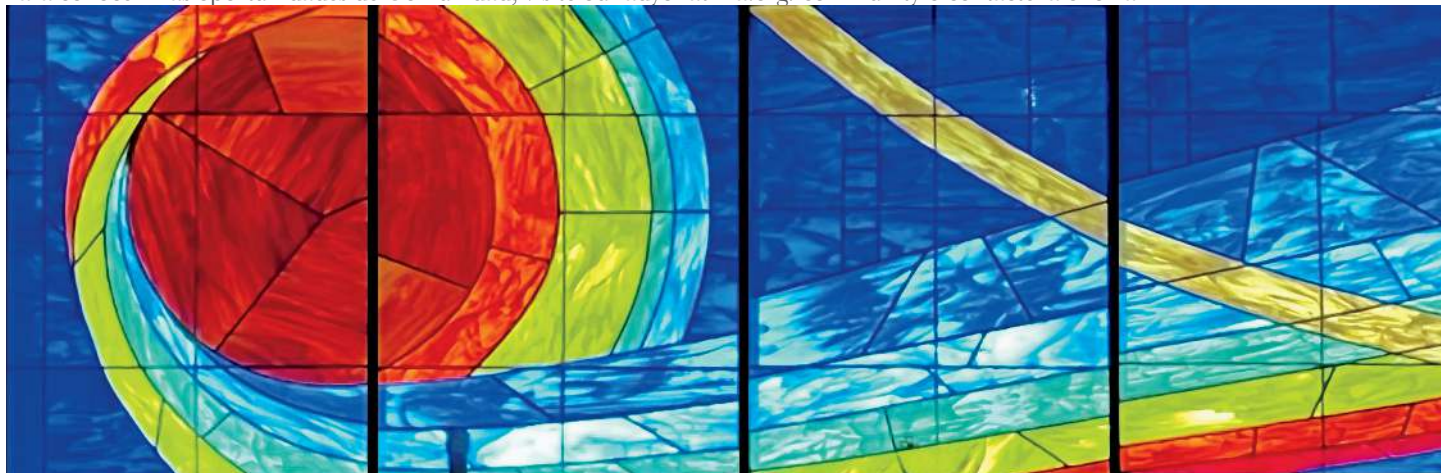

Care For Creation

During this Season of Creation, consider the importance of pollinators. These bees, butterflies, bats and other animals allow $\frac{3}{4}$ of the world's flowering plants and 35% of all food crops to reproduce. The number of bees, butterflies, and bats are all declining around the world, meaning that our food crops are in trouble. The decrease in these animal populations is due to loss of habitat, toxic exposures, disease and other factors. The good news is that you can help bring these wonderful animals back!

- + Plant native plants in your yard to provide food and habitat for pollinators.
- + Don't use pesticides or herbicides in your yard and garden.
- + Visit the St. Kateri Pollinator garden located behind the Fatima Center to be inspired by God's creation at work.

"But ask the beasts, and they will teach you; the birds of the heavens, and they will tell you; or the bushes of the earth, and they will teach you; and the fish of the sea will declare to you. Who among all these does not know that the hand of the LORD has done this? In his hand is the life of every living thing and the breath of all mankind. (Job 12:7-10)

Focolare Movement

The Focolare Movement is a movement of Spiritual and social renewal founded by Chiara Lubich. It is present in 182 nations and more than 2 million people share closely in its life and work. The Focolare Movement aims at spreading the message of unity worldwide. Its goal is to promote brotherhood and to achieve a more united world in which people respect and value diversity.

Meetings are held on the first Sunday of the month with a potluck and sharing of scripture called the Word of Life.

The next meeting will be held on **Sunday, September 6** at 12:15 PM in the Columbus Room. Everyone is welcome to join for fellowship and sharing. The scripture discussion will be: "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord." (Lk 1:46)
