This report is for July 2026. You will see the Actual for July 2026, the Budget and the variance of Actual to Budget then Last July 2025 Actual, both in number and graph. I hope you find this helpful. Our Offertory income is down this year from last year and the projected budget. Understandable as this is when many people are away and on vacation. Our expenses do NOT include the concrete work which was done this summer and it is NOT included in the budget. As of July that amount is \$35,925. Since it is a capital expense it will be handled with funds we have in savings - if needed. There are more monetary expenses coming on this project in August/September, the final payment and the railings. New flooring (vinyl) is going into the Hospitality room, Angel's Corner, the Library and the Nursery as soon as they will schedule with us. That expense will be \$12,400. 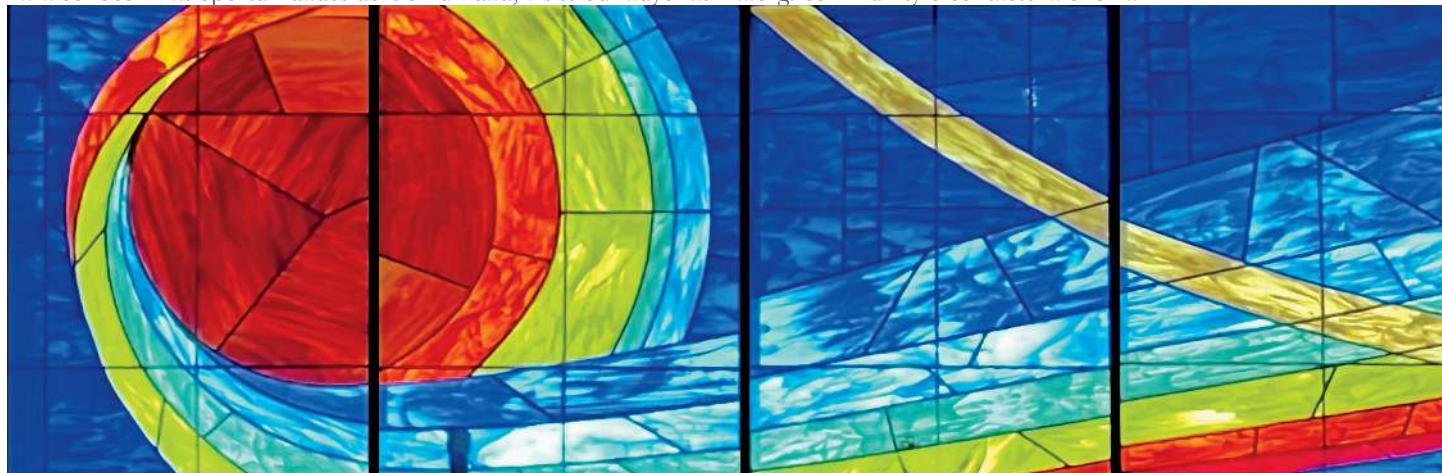

Care For Creation

Caring for creation can be as simple as remembering what your mother always told you to do - don't waste your food! It is estimated that between 30-40% of the food supply in this country is wasted. Besides the obvious problem of that food not going to people who need the nourishment, there are environmental impacts as well. One of the major ones is what happens to food when it is thrown in the landfill. Because of the way that the food decomposes in a landfill, methane gas is produced (a very potent greenhouse gas) which contributes to climate change. With just a little extra effort we can minimize the negative impact our diet has on our common home and our neighbors. Plan your meals in advance so that you don't buy more perishable food than you can eat. Consider composting your food scraps. A multitude of YouTube videos are available to teach everyone from apartment dwellers to families with plenty of composting space how to turn food waste to nutrient rich soil. "When they had all had enough to eat, he said to his disciples, 'Gather the pieces that are left over. Let nothing be wasted'." John 6:12
