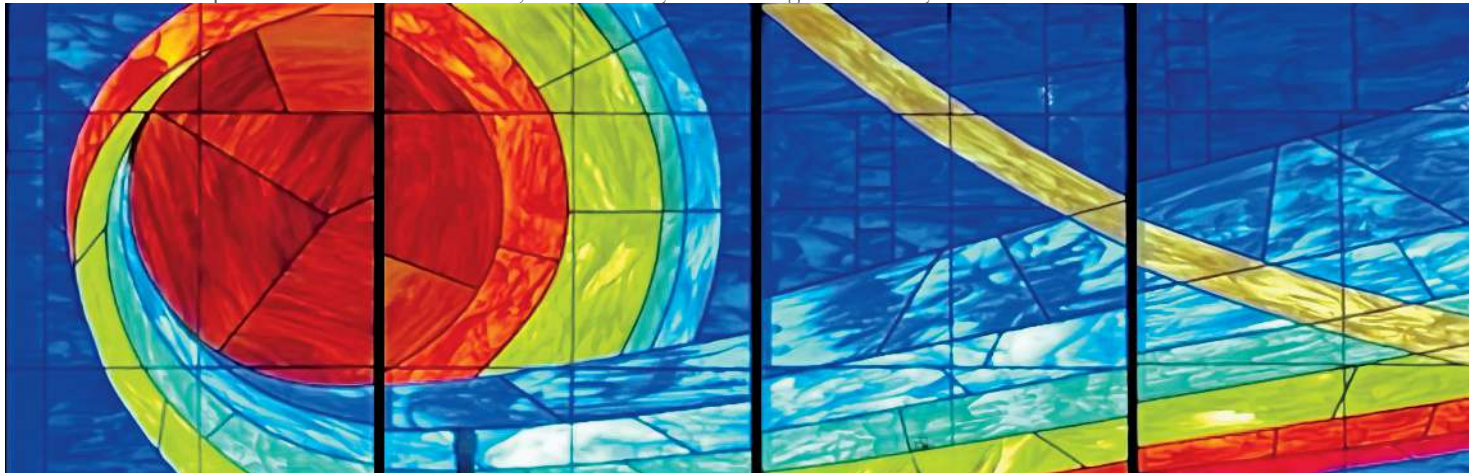

An easy way to take care of our common home is to modify our buying habits. The production, packaging, and transportation of new items takes a huge toll on the environment. Anything that we can do to limit how much we buy and how we dispose of our used possessions will help Earth to breathe easier. Visit thrift stores or consignment stores to buy previously owned clothes, and other essentials. Many items are like new and will save you money as well as benefitting our environment.

- + Donate or sell items that are in good shape that could be used by someone else.
- + Recycle items that you cannot donate.
- + When you do buy new items, look for ones that are made from recycled materials. Nowadays it is possible to buy anything from decking boards to clothing made of recycled fabrics.
- + Shop for free at a swap meet, where you can enjoy your neighbor's gently used pieces and pass on your no longer wanted items to a good home.
