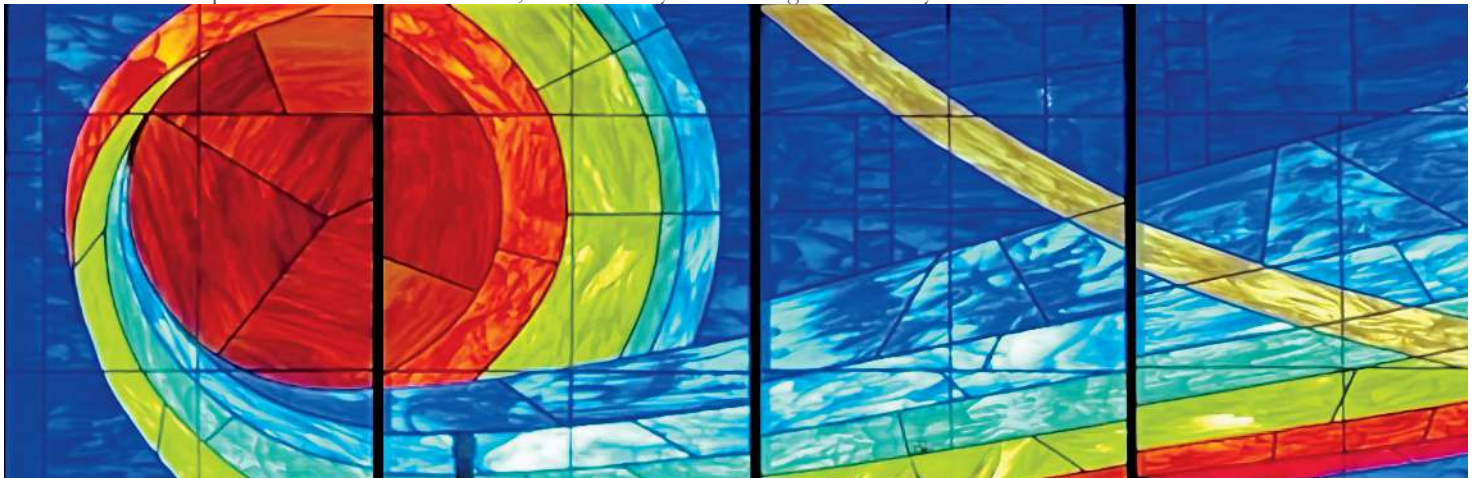

Care For Creation

When the Catholic Church teaches us to care for creation, it is not teaching us to worship the earth or make gods out of nature. It is instead acknowledging the truth that all of creation is made by God and intertwined with all other life. As Pope Francis wrote in *Laudate Deum*, "human life is incomprehensible and unsustainable without other creatures" and "all of us are linked by unseen bonds and together form a kind of universal family" with God as its head. We care for creation by caring for each other; by caring for the plants and animals that feed us and keep the web of life intact, and by looking at the world through the eyes of God. Our parish gives a great example of this through Martha's Hands, St. Joseph Helpers, the Healing Ministry and many other examples of outreach. The goal of the Care for Creation Ministry is to extend this outreach to the parts of creation that don't have a voice and are suffering. We welcome all who have an interest in extending God's caring hand to the home we all share.

Focolare Movement

The Focolare Movement is a movement of Spiritual and social renewal founded by Chiara Lubich. It is present in 182 nations and more than 2 million people share closely in its life and work. The Focolare Movement aims at spreading the message of unity

worldwide. Its goal is to promote brotherhood and to achieve a more united world in which people respect and value diversity.

Meetings are held on the first Sunday of the month with a potluck and sharing of scripture called the Word of Life.
