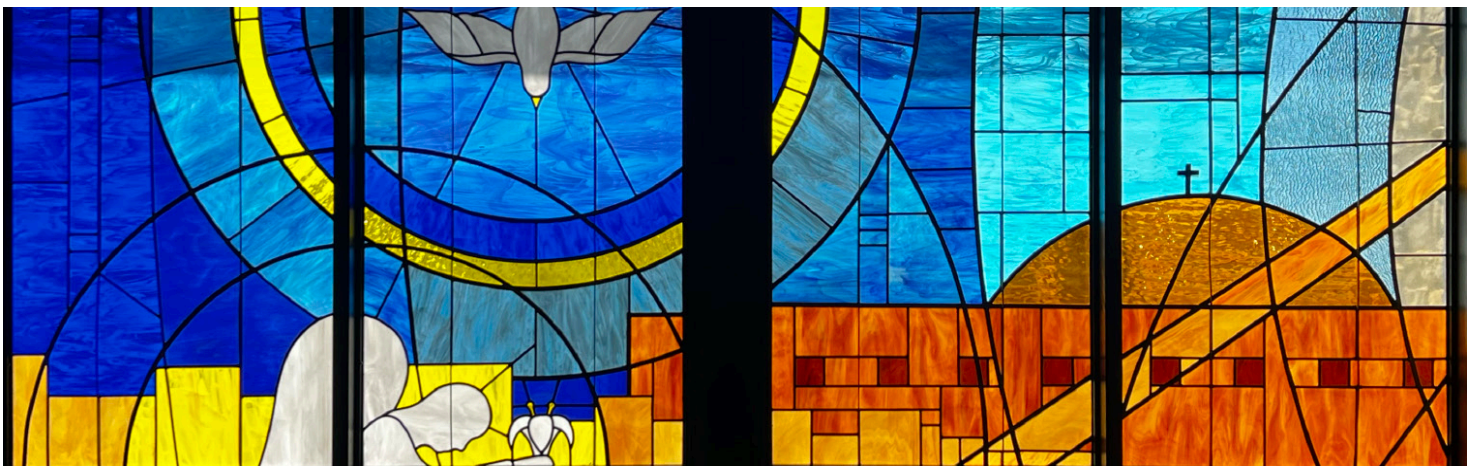

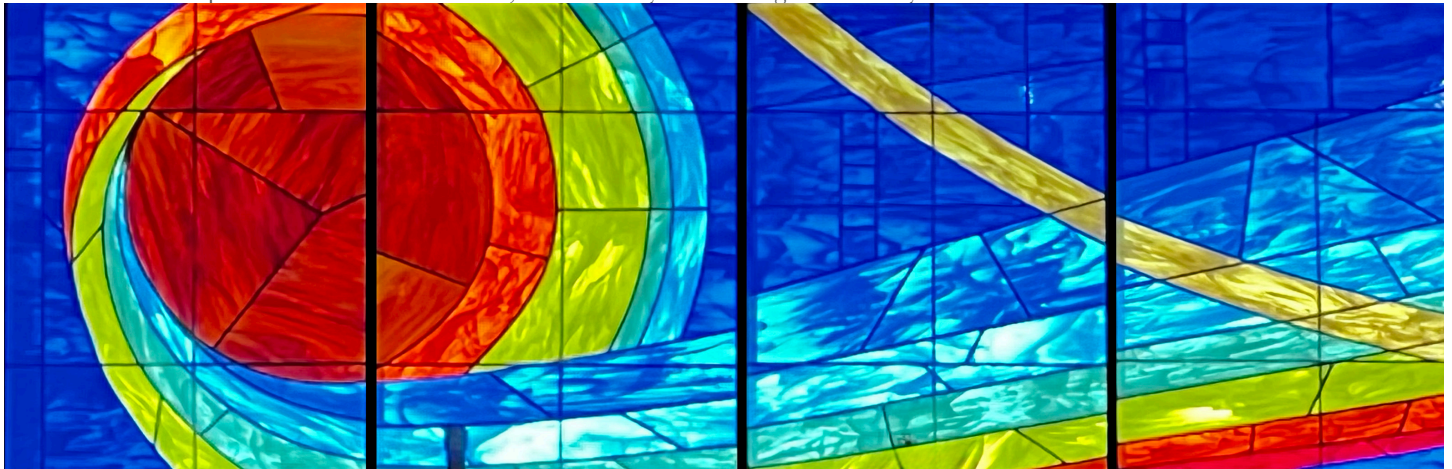

Why We Pray the Rosary for the Holy Souls in Purgatory

At the heart of Catholic spirituality lies a profound tradition: praying for the souls in purgatory. This practice, deeply rooted in the Church's teaching on the Communion of Saints, finds a particularly powerful expression in praying the Rosary for the Holy Souls. But why do we dedicate this time and prayer to the souls who have passed from this earthly life?

Understanding Purgatory

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 1030–1032) describes purgatory as a state of purification for those who die in God's grace but who are not yet fully purified. It is a merciful gift from God, a place of cleansing from venial sins and the temporal effects of sins before entering heaven.
